## **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-18**

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, FLORIDA APPROVING THE HIRING OF CHRISTIA ALOU AS EL PORTAL INTERIM VILLAGE MANAGER, UPON TERMS SPECIFIED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to employ an Interim Village Manager for the Village of El Portal; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has decided to hire Christia Alou as Interim Village Manager, anticipating the Interim Village Manager position to last for approximately four (4) months, unless terminated sooner, or extended, by the Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Village Manager is to post a bond, which shall be paid for by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Village Manager shall have the duties and responsibilities set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Village Manager will be entitled to compensation as specified herein; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The Village Council of the Village of El Portal hereby hires Christia Alou as Interim Village Manager, on the following terms and conditions: The compensation to be paid to the Interim Village Manager, Christia Alou, shall be an annual salary of \$85,000.00, pro-rated, payable bi-weekly in equal installments, together with a monthly auto allowance of \$400.00 In addition, the Interim Village Manager shall receive such paid holidays as are provided to other employees, cell phone and such other equipment as is necessary for her to perform Village duties, and accrual of personal/sick leave at the rate of one-half day per month, accruing pro rata for each pay period; and any expenses for items such as approved travel shall be approved in advance by the Village Council.

Section 3. The Village Council and the Mayor, along with the Village Clerk, Village Attorney and CFO, are hereby authorized to take all necessary and expedient action to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
