**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION FOR COUNCILPERSONS; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.06 of the Charter of the Village of El Portal provides that the compensation of Councilpersons shall be set by ordinance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that the just and proper annual compensation for Councilpersons shall be \$4,500, payable in quarterly installments; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has also determined that councilpersons shall be entitled to participate in the Florida Retirement System (FRS) in the same manner as other Village Employees.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** The annual compensation for Councilpersons shall be fixed at four thousand five hundred dollars (4,500), payable in quarterly installments; and councilpersons shall be entitled to participate in the Florida Retirement System (FRS) in the same manner as other Village Employees.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** If any section, part of section, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall not be affected.

**SECTION 5: Inclusion in the Code.** It is the intention of the Village Council and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made

a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of El Portal, Florida, that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intentions, and that the word Ordinance shall be changed to Section or other appropriate word.

**SECTION 6: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption on second reading.
