

**RESOLUTION 2017-40**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE 2018 TITLE VI FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) PROGRAM AND POLICIES ; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and 49 CFR Part 21, the U.S. Department of Transportation and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) prohibit discrimination, and state “no person in the United States shall on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, as a recipient of federal funds, the Village of El Portal is required to comply with the requirements of the Act and applicable implementing regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Title VI non-discrimination laws in regard to providing appropriate access to services and activities provided by federal agencies and recipients of federal assistance, the Village of El Portal will comply with Title VI Program and Policies; and

**WHEREAS**; the Village of El Portal, Florida, approves the Village’s Title VI Program and Policies, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The recitals to the preamble herein are incorporated by reference.

**Section 2.** The Village Council of El Portal, Florida, hereby approves the Title VI Program and Policies, as set forth substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, entitled Village of El Portal Title VI Program Plan .


**Section 3** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
