

Bulk Item Pickup Do's and Don'ts



DO NOT place any items under low hanging tree limbs or power lines. To prevent damage to your property, keep bulk items 5 feet away from your:

- **Trash cart • Mailbox • Fences or walls • Water meter**
- **Telephone connection box • Parked cars**

Be sure all tree branches and wood are no bigger than 3 feet long and 2 ½ feet in diameter. Place all furniture, including tables, chairs, and sofas at the curb

DO NOT place non-processed material from large, full-grown trees including trunks, stumps and roots. Tree branches and wood must not be larger than 3 feet in length and 2 ½ feet in diameter.



DO NOT place construction materials (concrete, dirt, rock, gravel, concrete blocks, drywall) at curb. Construction debris is solid waste derived from the construction, repair, remodeling of structures and will not be collected.



DO NOT place oil, paint, batteries or any other hazardous materials out for collection. They will not be accepted.

Items NOT accepted in bulk collection include carpet, tires, refrigerators, freezer, hazardous materials and construction materials. Automotive and marine: engine, drivetrain or other similar vehicle parts.

Miami Dade County Home Chemical Collection Center accept the following:

- Oil based paints
- Pesticides, solvents
- Pool Chemicals
- Electronic items including computer monitors and televisions; personal computers, keyboards, hard drives and printers; VCR's and video equipment; and cellular phones and radios
- Unbroken fluorescent light bulbs, including the older, long-tube fluorescents, modern compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) and other fluorescent types
- Latex paints that are still in liquid form
- Propane tanks (larger tanks such as those used for RV's, forklifts, or fixed kitchen gas supply are not accepted)
- Empty oxygen tanks
