

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE EL PORTAL, FLORIDA OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, MAINTAINING A TITLE VI/NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY AND PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 FOR THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the Village of El Portal is a sub recipient of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Stimulus Grant through the Miami Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works and is required to maintain a Title VI/Non-Discrimination Policy and Plan in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, Title VI/Non-Discrimination Policy and Plan for the Village of El Portal, which complies with the federal requirements, helps not only to manage complaints efficiently by having set procedures, information, and points of contact, but also to proactively discourage discrimination on the basis of race, color or national origin; and

WHEREAS the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) 2019 Title VI Program Update (FTA C4702.1B) requires the Title VI/Non-Discrimination Policy and Plan be approved by the governing body by way of resolution; and

WHEREAS The Title VI/Non-Discrimination Policy and Plan must be updated every three years; and

WHEREAS, the Village of EL Portal hereby finds the updated Title VI/Non-Discrimination Policy and Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part of this Resolution, to be in the best interest of the Village of El Portal.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OF VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: The Village EL Portal hereby approves and adopts the Village of EL Portal Title VI/Non-Discrimination Policy and Plan (Exhibit A).

Section 3: The City Manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to carry out the aims of the Resolution.

Section 4: The City Manager is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Miami Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works.


Section 5: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.




