

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL, OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA, OFFICE OF THE STATE ATTORNEY FOR THE ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA TO REIMBURSE THE STATE FOR THE COST OF STATE ATTORNEY PROSECUTION OF CERTAIN CRIMINAL VIOLATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of El Portal (the “Village”) and the Office of the State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida (“State Attorney”) both desire to maintain and improve the health, safety, and welfare of this community; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds it is necessary to adequately enforce and prosecute violations of the Village’s Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.02, Florida Statutes, authorizes the State Attorney to prosecute municipal ordinance violations punishable by incarceration if ancillary to state prosecution or, if not ancillary to state prosecution, when the State Attorney contracts with the Village for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the Village hereby finds the Agreement between the Village and the State Attorney, attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part of this Resolution, to be in the best interest of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OF VILLAGE OF EL PORTAL:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

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Section 2: The Village of El Portal hereby approves and adopts the Agreement between the Village of El Portal and the Office of the State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida attached hereto as Exhibit A.


Section 3: The Village Manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to carry out the aims of the Resolution.


